If you are a first timer to a Samboree, you should head for Dr. Sambones' table as soon as you check in and setup your rig. Why? And who is this Doctor Sambones anyway?

Chapter volunteers are Dr. Sambones who are armed with the information you need to get the most from your Samboree experience.

There you will find a program of events and seminars at the ready in case you left your program in the rig. A log of all registered campers is available in case you need to find a friend and don't know where they're parked. They have information about nearby medical, veterinary, and laundry facilities, as well as shopping centers and churches.

Find out about where to sign-up for outdoor and indoor games, etc. They also have sign-up sheets for those interested in a table at the Chapter Flea Market (if scheduled). At some Samborees, you can arrange for a sewer pump-out (Honey Wagon) or register for individual or chapter participation for the theme parade, site decoration competition.

The table is filled with free pamphlets, maps, and other tourist information. Help yourself! If in spite of all the available information, you still have a question that we can't answer, they'll research it and get back to you.

Lost and found? Check Dr. Sambones. Did you miss getting a first-timer ribbon? Come back to Dr. Sambones. Need information about chapters in your area? The volunteers can help you.

Volunteers are at the table at certain hours, so check your program. But even when the volunteers are out, you can still review the sign-up sheets for events.
